

REPORT OF DEPARTMENT CHAPLAIN.

Commander and Comrades: At the close of another year we have assembled in this, another encampment, for the purpose of transacting such business as may properly come before us, and we sincerely hope that in our deliberations we may do all that we do for the best interests of our noble order. May peace, harmony and unity prevail.

It is with mingled feelings of pain and pleasure, of sadness and sorrow and of joy and gladness that we meet upon occasions like this. We are pained, sad and sorrowful when we think of deceased comrades who have departed this life and have gone to the bourne from whence no one e'er returns. But we who are here rejoice and are glad that we still have a place among the living. We may rejoice to-day in the knowledge that we have not lived in vain. We can congratulate ourselves on the fact that we are a part of that great army of men who in the perilous times of '61 to '65 offered themselves in defense of their country and offered them selves that their country might be one and only one people. Now it is with pride and satisfaction that we can contemplate how she has marched on from conquest to conquest, removing all the obstructions that would impede her progress and surmounting all the mountains of difficulty, so that to-day she stands as the greatest, richest and freest nation in the world.

But, comrades, there is still work for us to do. Our country is again in a state of war. We have arrayed against us a relentless and ruthless foe, who cares not for international treaties and bids defiance to all law and the rights of men and nations. This series of insults has been a menace to us. Shall we submit to the indignities that have been heaped upon us? No, no, be it far from us; but rather let us arise as one man in the power which God has given us, and say to our selfish, barbarous, cruel and inhuman foe, "Thus far shalt thou go and no farther."

Comrades, we have passed the meridian of life; the sun of our lives is setting behind the clouds of the western horizon. We have grown old and infirm. We are no longer physically able to endure the privations incident to a soldier's life. We could hardly shoulder a gun, unsheathe a sword or perform any of the duties incumbent on a soldier; but we can give of our time, our money and our influence to help in the war that is now on. Let us be true to our beloved country, and may the Star Spangled Banner still wave o'er land and sea until we are victorious and until time shall be no more.
