Five of the above Posts sustained a loss by death of seventy Comrades during the year 1908, as follows: Post No. 25 at Wichita, 16 deaths; Post No. 1 at Topeka, 15 deaths; Post No. 12 at Lawrence, 15 deaths; Post No. 429 at Wakefield, 14 deaths; Post No. 407 at South Haven, 10 deaths.
